

Guide for Parishes – Modifications to the SAD

- The final SAD was submitted to the Secretary of State on Friday 15th September 2017. This version of the Plan was agreed by Members at Full Council on 1st August 2017.
- Following on from discussions at the public hearing sessions held 28 November – 8 December 2017, the Inspector asked the Council to make some changes, known as Modifications, to the SAD. This is to help make the SAD ‘sound’.
- We now need to consult on the changes and the consultation period runs from 7 February – 5pm, 21 March 2018.
- The Inspector will consider the main proposed changes, and any responses made during the consultation period, to enable him to reach his final conclusions on the soundness of the SAD. You can also comment on some additional minor changes to the SAD, and to the addendum Sustainability Appraisal which takes account of these proposed changes.
- We have provided you with the following documents:

 - Schedule of Minor Modifications to the SAD
 - Legal Notice
 - Response Form
 - Guidance Note
 - A copy of the Addendum Sustainability Appraisal can be provided on request.
- Copies of the documents will also be available at the Council Offices in Codsall, and parish council offices and libraries across South Staffordshire. We have produced a guidance note and a response form which should help you to make representations. - This is a formal stage of consultation and it is important that representations only relate to the legal compliance/soundness of the Main Modifications. The Inspector will only consider representations which relate to the proposed changes and which are received during the consultation period.
