Presentation by V1th Form Community Project

The Chairman Cllr John Michell welcomed Jane de Weijer and a small group of students who were presenting the project this evening.

With the use of presentation boards, the project team illustrated how they will be transforming a 6th Form Common Room into a fundraising room, giving a professional focal point for local charities to utilise the skills and equipment available to help and direct fundraising activities.

New furniture and a variety of equipment are required and so far the Project Team have raised £5542, of a £8000 requirement.

The project team have a number of projects online, e.g. Raffle, Launch Party and a large charity event.

The refurbishment will take place over the summer break with the Launch Party taking place on the 5th September in time for the new academic year.

The Project team then answered numerous questions raised by Councillors.

The Chair thanked the Project Team for giving a very professional presentation, and that it was a unique and worthwhile facility being offered to our local fundraisers, this was endorsed by the meeting.
